

Trifold preparation



- Abstract not required
- "References" section required after "Future Directions"

Layout and Design

- Remember to create a catchy title!
- Must have a logical flow (see diagram)
- Adequate white space
- Maximum 3 main colours used
- All text and images "framed" and mounted onto colour paper
- Text needs to be easy to read from a distance (see slide preparation notes)
- Overall neatness is extremely important. Keep mounts level, make sure you do not have rips, tape showing, messy glue, etc.



- Support the topic
- Clear and easy to see
- Labeled
- Referenced, where did it come from

Oral presentations

- Prepare a 5 minute speech that summarizes your project
- Introduce yourself, your title and how you came up with your project.
- Go through your trifold explaining each section
- End by asking if there are any questions or feedback.
 Then say, "thank you for listening".
- Memorize your presentation but bring notes or cue cards.
- Practice for anyone you can!
- Partners need to share and both need to be prepared.
 Consider taking turns.
